School Cash Online is our school's preferred method of payment. Please join the thousands of parents who have already registered and are enjoying the convenience of paying ONLINE! It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

NOTE: If you require assistance, select the SUPPORT option in the top right hand corner of the screen.

Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page <u>https://holyspirit.schoolcashonline.com/</u> and select the *"Get Started Today"* option.
- b) Complete each of the Registration Steps
 *For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name
- b) Enter the School Name
- c) Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- d) Enter Your Child's ASN (available from your school)
- e) Select Continue
- f) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*
- g) Your child has been added to your account

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account.

If you do not wish to add additional children, select

"View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.

The St. Mary's Band Booster Club held its Annual General Meeting on Tuesday, September 21st. Thank you to all parents who attended this important meeting. Our first executive meeting of the year Tuesday, October 26th at 7:00 in the band room. All parents are welcome to attend.

The Band Booster Club has started its fundraiser for this year. We are currently selling items from the Dielemans catalogues. Funds from this program go towards the individual accounts of students. Please ensure that these orders are in by October 14th as well. All Dieleman products will be delivered to the school by mid-November. It is the responsibility of the student to make sure the products they sell get to the purchaser.

A reminder to all band students that our first public performance is the Christmas Concert on Wednesday, December 15th at 7:00 in the school gym. All students need to have a white dress shirt with no writing on it, or a white sweater, and a black pair of pants or skirt.

Grade 6-8 band students are reminded that they are to be handing in a practice sheet EVERY week. To receive full marks, students must practice 70 minutes per week. Extra practice sheets are available in the band room. Please remember that practice sheets are worth 10% of the band mark.

All band students are reminded that they need to hand in a Home Performance Assignment every calendar month. Forms are available in the band room and are due the first school day of the new month. Students are responsible for playing for an adult at home and having them fill out an evaluation form, as well as the student filling out a self-evaluation. Grade 6's will complete their first assignment in October. October's Home Performance Assignments are due November 1st.

The St. Mary's library has a collection of supplemental music books that are available for band students to check out. These are more popular pieces in the classical, jazz, rock and pop fields. Each one comes with a play-along cd that allows the student to hear background music during the song. These are a great idea for students to get in extra practice minutes, as well as just having fun on their instruments.


